

ORDINANCE 2009-2
An Ordinance Amending Chapter 7 Vehicle Parking

Section 700.02 Removal of Violating Vehicles; Authority to Provide Removal Service shall be amended to read:

Any vehicle parked in violation of this Chapter maybe removed by the Public Works Director or other authorized City employees, including the Sheriff, and towed away and stored at the expense of the owner. The City Council may make reasonable agreements with persons, firms or corporations who have garages in regard to the towing and storage of vehicles. The firms may be authorized by City representatives to tow and store vehicles located on any streets, alley or municipal parking lot in violation of this Section. The storage fee for vehicles stored on City property shall be as set in the fee schedule adopted from time to time by the Council.

Section 700.08 Subd. 2 Unlawful Overtime Parking shall be amended to read:

It shall be unlawful to park a car, pickup truck, van or motorcycle on any City street, alley or public parking lot for longer than:

- A. 12 consecutive hours from the period of November 1st to April 30th
- B. 48 consecutive hours from the period of May 1st to October 31st

Any person in violation of Subd. 2A&B shall receive a 12 hour warning tag from Olmsted County Sheriff's Dept. If after 24 hours the violation continues the vehicle may be towed.

Section 700.10 Unlawful to Park on City Streets During Snow Removal shall be amended to read:

It shall be unlawful for any person to park or leave a vehicle, recreational vehicle, trailer or other device used for the transportation of persons, goods, refuse, boats, motors or other merchandise on any street or roadway when continuous or intermittent snowfall has accumulated two

inches (2") or more of snow, ice or similar debris on any street or roadway and until all snow, ice, and similar debris has been plowed or removed from the improved portion of the roadway or street. The City may issue a ticket for violation after two hours and again after 12 hours if the vehicle has not been moved. After 24 hours the vehicle may be towed. Nothing in this Section shall limit, prohibit, or restrict the duty and authority of the persons mentioned in Subsection 700.03 of this Section from posting more limited or restrictive parking designations in residentially zoned areas.
